The Diocesan Center located at 2158 Route 106 Muttontown, NY 11791, sprawls out on almost 3 acres of lush greenery of trees, shrubs, and vines, with 500 feet road frontage. Let us all thank God for this beautiful place.

There are two buildings that extend almost 10,000 square feet and consists of offices, chapel hall, corridors, breeze ways, a 1000 square feet of granite porch, 60 square feet long roof deck and about 8,800 square feet driveway which can park more than 30 cars.

The old building is fully renovated with modern amenities with a 1,000 square feet brick patio in the back. The new building is equipped with an elevator. There are 10 bedrooms of which 3 are bedroom suites, two spacious living rooms and a chapel that has a seating capacity for one hundred people. The dining room can also serve as a conference room for more than 15 people, with a spacious library adjacent to it.

The lower level is a 3,000 square foot office area with a separate entrance, fully air conditioned, with granite floors and two bathrooms. There are finished office spaces for spiritual organizations and a 600 square feet Diocesan Office with three modern work stations.
